With the additional C100G deployments within its footprint, Mediacom has been able to quickly and cost-effectively convert to DOCSIS® 3.1 and is poised to make its entire broadband network service area gigabit-ready by the end of 2016.

With DOCSIS® 3.1 enabled in both the upstream and downstream on the C100G, operators can deploy gigabit services today while being well-positioned to scale and provide additional services down the road – without the need to rip and replace switch cards, line cards or PHY modules. Providers can also evolve to a distributed access architecture (DAA) using the existing C100G and just one new card in the CCAP core. Service providers deploying the C100G have demonstrated significant OPEX savings in the areas of energy, facilities, maintenance and management. Simultaneously, they have been able to offer their end users higher speed tiers and a better customer experience.
